

Paediatric COVID-19 Assessment Tool

Triage Criteria requiring NP/MD assessment

Any **ONE** of the following “**High Risk**” criteria?

- Breathing/drinking/mental status problems
- 3-6 months old (<3mo should go to ED)
- Abnormal vitals (see below)
- Fever for 3+ days
- Parental concern
- Concurrent conditions*

*Conditions to consider (not exhaustive):
Pregnancy, cancer, obesity, diabetes, cardiac issues, respiratory issues, neurological issues, developmental concerns

NP/MD to assess child

Any **ONE** of the following?

- Respiratory distress/failure
- Dehydration
- Altered level of consciousness
- Fever for 5+ days
- Concerning vital signs
- Any NP/MD COVID or Non-COVID related concerns

- Child sent home to isolate per public health guidelines
- Caregiver Guidance info given
- Plan for follow-up as needed

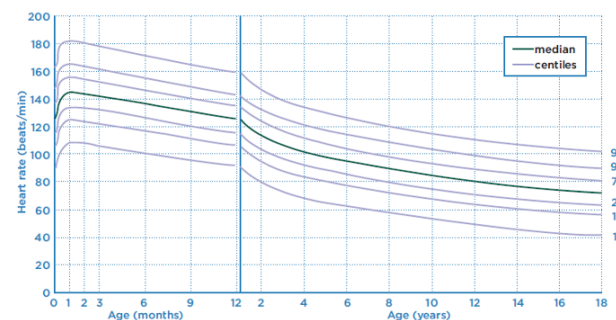
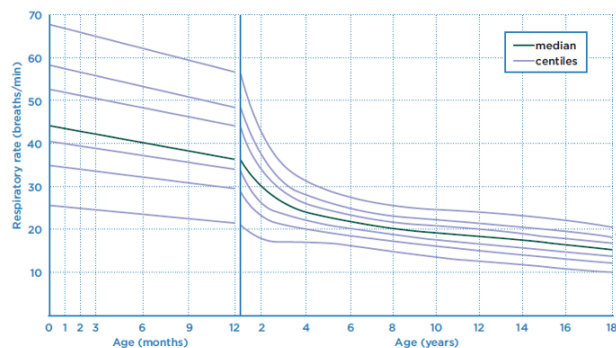
